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CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION

- National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), an autonomous organization established under Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India, invites online application from eligible and interested Indian Citizens for recruitment on Direct basis to the posts of Principal, Post Graduate Teachers, Trained Graduate Teachers, Hostel Warden (Male and Female), Female Staff Nurse, Accountant, Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA) and Lab Attendant.
- In addition to normal teaching duties, the teachers are required to perform responsibilities attached
 with residential system of schooling like House Mastership, remedial and supervisory studies,
 organization of co-curricular activities, escorting of students on official purposes and looking after
 students' welfare in general. During the period of probation of the incumbent, performance in all
 these areas will also be assessed, in addition to the teaching ability to determine suitability for the
 job.
- In respect of non-teaching staff, they are required to perform residential duties.
- All the stuff in EMRSs are eligible for special pay @ 10% of the basic pay.
- In view of the admission policy that girls and boys are admitted in the ratio of 1:1 in EMRS, efforts
 will be made to post male and female teachers as per the approved policy of NESTS i.e., minimum
 of 20% and maximum of 60% female staff in each EMRS and as per the administrative need of
 EMRSs subject to the condition that they fulfill the normal eligibility conditions. However, there
 is no separate reservation for Female Teachers to this effect.
- The candidates may be posted anywhere in India on initial posting on selection and request for change of station/region will not be entertained under any circumstances whatsoever.

Objectives of EMRS

Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs) are established with the objective of providing quality education from Class VI to XII students belonging to ST category. These schools are set up at block level as residential schools and have separate hostels for boys and girls, accommodation for staff, mess facility, playground and all other amenities. EMRSs, being fully residential institutions, teaching and non-teaching staff are required to stay on campus for which rent free accommodation as available will be provided.

- Candidates are required to apply through "Online" mode only for the post(s) as per the
 advertisement/vacancy notified. The Application form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- 2. While filling online application form on the portal, the candidates will have to fill their generic particulars in Part—A correctly because their category and PwD/PwBD status filled in Part—A is linked to Part—B of the application form. After filling Part—A, the candidates will have to fill up Part—B for each post separately (for which the candidates wish to apply). Once the Part—B for any one of the posts is filled by a candidate, no change in the part A will be allowed.
- A candidate may apply for more than one post, if be/she is eligible. In such cases, the candidate will
 have to pay the requisite fee separately for each post as applicable. However, a candidate can apply
 only for one post of PGT against various PGT posts and can apply only for one post of TGT against
 various TGT posts.
- 4. Candidates will have to pay fees separately, if he/she is applying for more than one post.
- The candidates should fill only one application form for one post. Multiple applications submitted by a candidate for same post, if detected at any stage, will be cancelled.
- No Application fee is required to be paid by candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD categories & Women candidates. However, processing fee as applicable (given in above table) is required to be paid by each and every candidate.
- 7. The tier-I examination for the recruitment of Principals will be only in Delhi while for other posts, the cities of examination will be decided according to the number of applicants. Therefore, the candidates have not been given option in the application form to select examination cities. The

allotment of examination city to the candidates will be done on random basis. The examination agency reserves the right to allot examination city to candidates anywhere in India due to administrative reasons. Decision of the examination agency will be final. The examination city/centre, once allotted shall not be changed under any circumstances. The request in this regard, for whatsoever reason, shall not be entertained.

- The information related to examination city allotted to the candidates for Tier I and Tier-II shall be displayed on the website of NESTS or through candidates' application log-in.
- Candidates must carefully read the instructions contained in the online application format/vacancy notified / information bulletin on the website for filling up the application form. Candidates not complying with the instructions will liable to be summarily disqualified.
- Functional requirements as notified by the Ministry of Social Justice vide Gazette Notification no. CG-DL-E-13012021-224370 dated Junuary 7, 2021 are to be fulfilled by all candidates for the post for which online application is submitted.
- 11. The online applications should be filled carefully as per instructions contained in the online application format and submit the same Online. Login ld and password would be generated on successful submission of application for registration and will be sent on the registered e-mail address of the candidate. Candidates are advised to preserve their login ld and password for future use.
- 12. Candidates shall ensure that the information entered by them in their respective online Application Form is correct. Information provided by the candidates in their respective online Application Forms, like, name of candidate, contact/address details, category, PwBD status (including sub-categories), educational qualification details, date of birth, experience details will be treated as final.
- 13. NESTS does not edit/modify/alter any information entered by the candidates after completion of application process under any circumstances. Any request for change in information thereafter will not be entertained. Therefore, candidates are advised to exercise utmost caution while filling up details in the Application Form.
- 14. The candidature will be considered based on the information filled by candidate in the Application Form. Any other information submitted subsequently or in modification will not be considered for candidature under any case. Moreover, if the candidate fails to submit documentary evidence to support the information filled at any stage of the recruitment process, the candidature will be rejected.
- 15. NESTS disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate(s) due to incorrect information provided by him/her in his/her online Application Form.
- 16. Selected candidates will be initially on probation for a period of two years, which can be extended at the discretion of the Competent Authority. During the probation period, services of probationer can be terminated at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
- 17. Qualifications acquired by the candidates should be strictly in accordance with the notified/ prescribed qualifications only. Wherever, grades /CGPA have been given, the position of the marksheets showing equivalent percentage of marks should be produced at the time of interview/ Personal Interaction/ document verification/ selection.
- 18. In case of variation between English and Hindi version of this advertisement, content of English version shall be treated as final.
- 19. After examination, the facility to download scanned copy of attempted OMR sheets will be available only for limited period which will be notified on the website of NESTS. After that period, the same

will not be made available by NESTS.

- 20. The confirmation page of the online Application Form will be generated only after successful payment of fees by the candidate. In case, the confirmation page is not generated after payment of fee, the candidate may have to approach the concerned Bank/Payment Gateway. NESTS shall not be responsible for any refund under these circumstances.
- 21. Candidates must ensure that their email address and mobile number to be registered in their online Application Form are valid as relevant/important information/communication will be sent on the registered e-mail address and/or through SMS on registered mobile number only. All the communications regarding the recruitment shall be made through email or displayed in candidates' application log-in only. NESTS shall not be responsible for any non-communication/ miscommunication with a candidate if the email address or mobile number given by him/her is incorrect.
- In case, if email is not delivered due to wrong email id/inbox is full/other administrative reasons. NESTS will not be responsible.
- Candidates shall appear at their own cost at the Examination Centre on the date, shift and time indicated on their Admit Cards.
- 24. Registered candidates are advised to visit the website and check their e-mails/application log-in regularly for the latest updates.
 - Candidates are required to have a valid and operative personal email ID and mobile phone number. It should be kept active during the currency of this recruitment. NESTS through its exam conducting agency may send call letters for ESSE and personal interaction/interview/ skill test, as the case may be, etc. on the registered e-mail ID of the candidate or the same may be downloaded from candidates application log-in or link available on the NESTS website. Under no circumstances, candidate should share/mention email ID to/or of any other person.
 - In case, a candidate does not have a valid and operative personal email ID, he/she should create his/her new email ID before applying Online and keep it active during the currency of this recruitment.
- 25. Any candidate found to be misleading by providing inaccurate information will be debarred from taking this recruitment examination and his/her candidature for any post will automatically be treated as rejected.
- 26. In case, it is found at any time in future that the candidate has used/uploaded the photograph, signature and certificate(s) of someone else in his/her Application Form/Admit Card or he/she has tampered his/her Admit Card, these acts of the candidate shall be treated as Unfair Means (UFM) / Practices on his/her part and he/she shall be proceeded with necessary actions.
- 27. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry Instruments, Geometry or Pencil box, Handbag, Purse, any kind of Paper/ Stationery/ Textual material (printed or written material), Eatables and Water (loose or packed), Mobile Phone/Earphone/Microphone/Pager, Calculator, DocuPen, Slide Rules, Log Tables, Camera, Tape Recorder, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, any metallic item or electronic gadgets/devices in the Examination Hall/Room.

Important instruction:

A. Functional Requirements for Posts - Compliance by PwBD Candidates

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, it is hereby notified that candidates falling under the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) category must ensure compliance with the functional requirements prescribed for the post(s) for which they intend to apply.

- Verification of Functional Requirements: It shall be the responsibility of the PwBD candidates to ensure that they
 meet the functional requirements for the specific post(s) prior to applying.
- Certification Requirement: Candidates who are shortlisted for Interview document verification shall be required to
 mandatorily produce a certificate issued by Civil Surgeon or CMO of a government hospital. This certificate must
 substantiate that the candidate fulfills the functional requirements stipulated for the post(s) applied for.
- Consequence of Non-compliance: Failure to adhere to the aforementioned requirements may render the candidate ineligible for the post(s) concerned, without prejudice to any other condition of eligibility or selection crueria.
- B. Details regarding essential and desirable qualifications for various categories of posts. Pay Scales with Level, Age limit, Relaxation of age, Mode of Selection and other related details are given. In addition to the pay scale, selected candidates will be entitled to draw admissible allowances besides 10% special allowance for performing residential duties.

Other instructions: -

- Only Indian citizens are eligible to apply.
- b. The vacancies for the posts included in this recruitment notification are tensative and may increase or decrease. No claim will be entertained, if there is any variation in the number of posts/ delay in issuing the Appointment cum Posting Order.
- c. NESTS reserves the right to fill or not to fill or partially fill any of the above vacancies without assigning any reasons whatsoever. NESTS also reserves the right to cancel/ restrict / modify/ after the recruitment process, if required, without giving any further notice or assigning any reasons thereof.
- The recruitment shall be in accordance with the latest recruitment rules notified by NESTS and recruited Staff will be the employees of NESTS.
- Qualification acquired by the candidates should be strictly in accordance with the notified/prescribed qualifications
 only and necessary original certificates should be produced at the time of interview/document verification/ selection.
- f. The cut-off date for determining various eligibility criteria (Educational Qualifications, age limit etc.) will be 23.10.2025. Before applying applicants must satisfy themselves about their eligibility as on 23.10.2025. Even if the last date to submit application forms is extended due to administrative reasons, the cut-off date for determining various eligibility criteria (Educational Qualifications, age limit etc.) will be 23.10.2025.
- g. The Reservation policy of Govt, of India applicable for direct recruitment on all India basis will be followed. Merit list for each post will be prepared separately on the basis of marks scored in Tser-II of ESSE-2025 in respect of all posts except for the post of Principal & JSA.
- h. The written test of Tier-II will be followed by an interview for the post of Principal. Based on the performance in Tier-II of ESSE 2025 and keeping in view the number of vacancies, the candidate will be called for interview? Personal Interaction in the ratio of 1:3. Intimation to this effect will be uploaded on the website "https://nests.tribal.gov.in" in due course.
- i. In the case of Principal, ment list will be prepared on the basis of marks scored in Tier-II of ESSE-2025 and personal

- interaction/interview in the ratio 80% and 20% respectively. If the same score is obtained by many candidates, then the date of birth will be considered, with preference given to those born earlier.
- j. In the case of non-teaching staff, the final selection will be based on marks obtained in written in Tier-II of ESSE 2025 only subject to the outcome of document verification. However, in respect of JSA, candidates who qualified the skill test (typing test) only will be considered for preparing the morit list.

The income shall also include income from all sources i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. The EWS certificate (Appendix – III) must be based on the income for the financial year prior to the cut off date for determining the eligibility. i.e. on the basis of income for the financial year 2024-25.

- a. Also, candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shallbe excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of family income:
 - i. 5 Acres of agriculture land and above.
 - ii. Residential flat of 1000 Sq Ft and above.
 - iii. Residential plot of 100 Sq yards and above in notified municipalities.
 - iv. Residential plot of 200 Sq Yd and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- b. The property held by a family in different locations or different places / cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. (The term Family for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years).
- e. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an income and asset certificate issued by a competent authority. The income and asset certificate issued by any one of the following authorities shall only be accepted as candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:-
 - District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/ Collector /Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner; or
 - ii. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate;
 - iii. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehuldar; or
 - Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- d. The candidate applying against the vacancies reserved for EWS must possess Income and asset certificate as on cut off date of online application for this advertisement. Accordingly, these candidates are required to produce valid Income and asset certificate during document verification stage. And asset certificate should be valid for the year in which this recruitment notification is published. In case of non-compliance of aforesaid stipulations, their claim for reserved status under EWS shall not be entertained and the candidature of such candidates, if fulfilling all the eligibility conditions for General (UR) category, shall be considered under General (UR) vacancies only.

4.4 Other Buckward Class - Non creamy layer (OBC-NCL)

27% reservation is applicable as per the Government of India rules. With regard to date of issue of certificate to claim OBC reservation under NCL, it should be based on the income for the financial year prior to the cut off date for determining the eligibility. i.e. OBC NCL certificate issued on the basis of income for the financial year 2024-25 (Appendix - II).

4.5 Facilities for PwBD candidates to appear in the exam:

- i. Persons with disability of 40% or more, if filled the requirement of scribe in the application form, will be provided scribe at the centre by the Centre Superintendent. If the centre does not provide scribe, candidates may bring his/her own scribe with qualification of minimum one academic year below the minimum qualification for the post for which candidate is appearing for the test.
- The candidates will be allowed to meet the scribe for a 20-minute interaction session one hour before the start of the examination at the assigned examination centre.
- iii. The facility of Scribe will be allowed to any person with benchmark disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation writing including that of speed if so desired by him/her. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected—BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe will be allowed, if so desired by the person.
- iv. In case of other category of persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe will be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution as per proforma at Appendix-VD.
 - The candidates with disabilities and those covered under 2 (s) of RPwD Act, 2026 opting for scribe shall be required to submit the request at the time of examination as per proforms at Appendix – VE.
- v. The facility of scribe and/or compensatory time shall be granted to those persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(x) of the said Act, i.e. persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing subject to production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per proforma at Appendix VD.
- vi. Compensatory time to be allowed in PwBD case is 20 minutes per hour of examination. All PwBD candidates not availing the facility of scribe may be allowed additional time @ 20 minutes per hour of examination duration.
- Reservation for person with disabilities in r/o the vacancies notified will be given as per the rules. No candidate will be permitted for the written (OMR Based) test without the proper Admit Card.

CHAPTER 5. UNFAIR MEANS PRACTICES AND BREACH OF EXAMINATION RULES

5.1 Definition of Unfair Means Practices

Unfair Means practice is an activity that allows a candidate to gain an unfair advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used for unfair practices including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, entable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned.
- b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying:
- Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by NESTS in connection with ESSE-2025 from time to time;
- d) Assisting other candidate to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance directly or indirectly of any kind or attempting to do sec
- c) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates:
- g) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. Admit Card, Self-Declaration, etc.;
- () Forceful entry/exit from Examination Centre/Hall;
- Use or attempted use of any electrocic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- k) Affixing/oploading of wrong/morphed photographs/signature on the Application Form/Admit Card/ Proforma;
- Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of examination.
- m) Any other mulpractices declared as Unfair Means by the NESTS.

5.2 Punishment for using Unfair means practices

During the course of, before or after the examination if a cardidate includes in any of the above or similar practice, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIR MEANS (U.F.M.) case shall be disqualified. The candidate shall also be liable for criminal proceedings and /or any other action as deemed fit.

5.3 Cancellation of Result

The result of ESSE-2025 of the candidate(s) who indulge in Unfair means Practices will be cancelled and will not be declared.
